




## 11th IAFSS Proceedings Printing Survey Summary

- Electronic publication is the best way forward.
- From my position it is sufficient that the proceedings are available. An indexing of the papers would be desirable that they can be found by google scholar or scifinder.
- I appreciated being sent a copy of the proceedings as part of presenting at the symposium, and I value my collection of past proceedings.
- I think at \$300-\$400 it is a bit steep. What I think would make sense would be a low-cost CD of the papers, since downloading them all is a hassle.
- I would prefer a soft copy of the book rather than a hard copy. Which is eco friendly and also more paper will be prone to more fire accidents..
- IAFSS proceedings need to continue to be available on-line at no cost to download. If that continues to be the case, then printed copies are unnecessary.
- It would prudent to section and page-number the proceedings even in the e-volume for easy referencing. Author and/or subject indexing or search function
- Only the draft version is currently available on-line. When will a final version be available on-line? It is important that this is done so that the papers can be cited correctly in the literature.
- The current online system is fantastic.
- The online version is more accessible and useful than a printed version. It is also more environmentally responsible to only provide an online version.
